

## Summer Camp Packing List

**Please do not pack the following items but bring them with you to the registration desk at check-in time:**

**All medications** must be turned in to the Camp Nurse at registration time and must be brought to camp in their original containers with pharmacy label intact. Medications include prescription as well as over-the-counter items such as Tylenol, Advil, and Aspirin.

**All money for the Camp Store** must be turned in at registration time. Each camper's balance will be monitored during the week and unspent money returned at the end of camp.

**All money for the Summer Offering** must be turned in at registration time. This year's offering will be used to continue our work on the new Cabents! Cabent = cabin/tent. Each Cabent has a solid roof, permanent bunk beds with safety rails, a porch and canvass sides.

***Please do not bring hand-held electronic games, cell phones, jewelry, pocketknives, axes, radios, video games, cd/tape players or recorders, candy, gum, food, pagers, alcohol, guns or tobacco – or any other valuable items to camp!***

**Please pack** the following items & mark them with your name: Bible, Flashlight, Writing Kit (pen or pencil, notebook, letter writing supplies), Bedroll (sleeping bag or 2 sheets & blankets), Optional Fitted Sheet & Twin-Size Egg Crate Foam Pad, Pillow, Toiletries (Soap in Container, Toothbrush & Toothpaste, Comb), sunscreen.

**Clothing:** Old Jeans & Shorts, Shirts (some with long sleeves), Underclothes, Pajamas, At Least 2 Pairs of Shoes & Socks, Warm Jacket or Sweatshirt, Rain Gear, Swimsuit & Towel

**Optional Items:** Water-Proof Ground Cloth (4x6 or larger), Dirty Clothes Bag, Insect Repellant (Cutters or Deep Woods Off are best – No Aerosols, Please).
